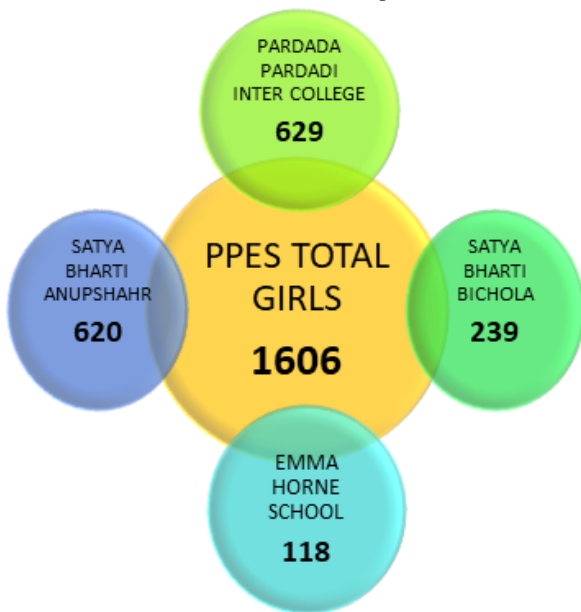

NATIONAL CADET CORPS AT PPES SCHOOL

National Cadet Corps, (NCC) is the youth Wing of Indian Armed Forces that aims at developing character, comradeship, discipline, a secular outlook and ideals of selfless service amongst young citizens studying at school and college level. Keeping this in mind Pardada Pardadi School introduced NCC from the academic year of 2019. 25 PPES girls are selected to join National Cadet Corps. The young cadets participated in two important rallies that aimed to raise awareness on air pollution and the ill effects of alcohol abuse.

CAREER GUIDANCE SESSION

In May, 2019, a career guidance session was conducted by IL&FS Institute of Skills, New Delhi for class 12th girls. The institute offers Tata Institute of Social Science (TISS) certified three year Learn & Earn vocational course in Hotel Management. Mr. Dheeraj Kumar, Centre Head, IL&FS Skills facilitated the session and urged the girls to join the unique program. Eight PPES girls joined the hotel management course in July, 2019.

FUN AT SUMMER CAMP

In May 2019, 35 PPES girls from class 6th to class 11th went for a summer youth camp to Sri Aurobindo Ashram, Nainital. Girls who demonstrated exemplary qualities of good attendance, good academic performance, leadership quality, punctuality, dedication to studies and human values, during 2018-19 academic year were rewarded by being chosen for the summer camp. At the summer camp our girls got opportunities to meet new friends from different schools, across India.

CONNECTING WITH NATURE

On 5th June Environment day is celebrated at PPES School. Going green and creating love for nature is a core component of PPES philosophy. The 'PPES Tree Program' is a unique approach that aims to create love and respect amongst PPES girls for the environment, and they learn it from their very first day at school. Under this program, more than 3000 trees have been planted in the school since 2000. Today the saplings have turned into mature trees and giving green coverage to the school.

On 22nd June, international Yoga Day was observed at PPES School. Hundreds of girls participated and demonstrated various yogic Asanas and Kriyas. The yoga day celebration was covered by various local and national newspapers.

At PPES school, Yoga is taught as a core co-curricular subject as it gives the perfect building block for healthy development. Yoga is also emerging as an alternative career option, and thirteen PPES graduates have chosen it as their career path. Nine girls have already completed their Yoga Therapy courses, and four are pursuing BSc. Yoga.

CREATIVITY AT ITS BEST...

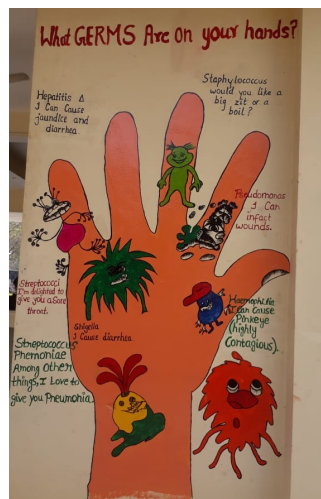

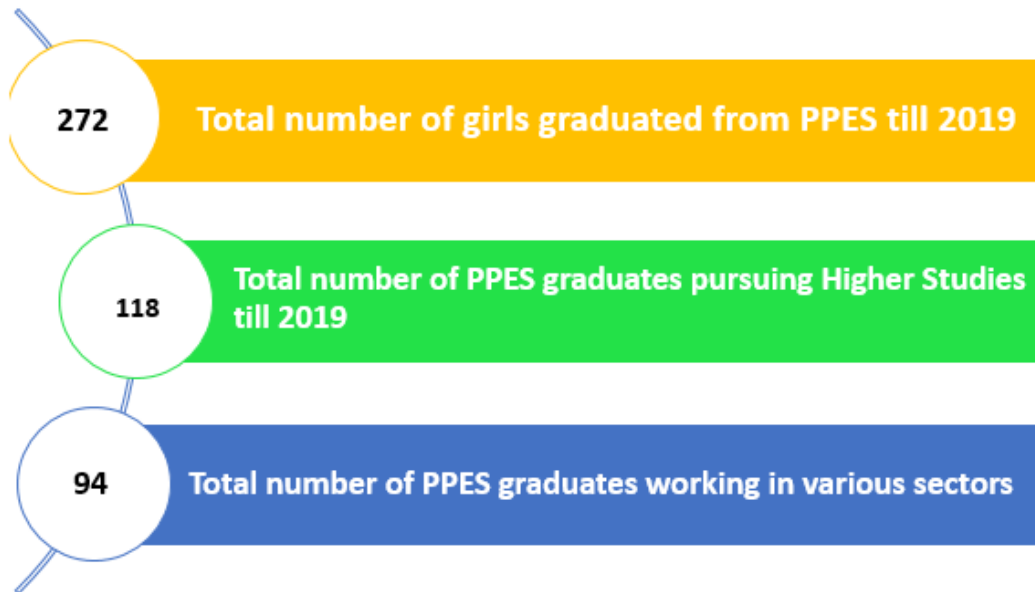

Highlights of Higher Education till June, 2019

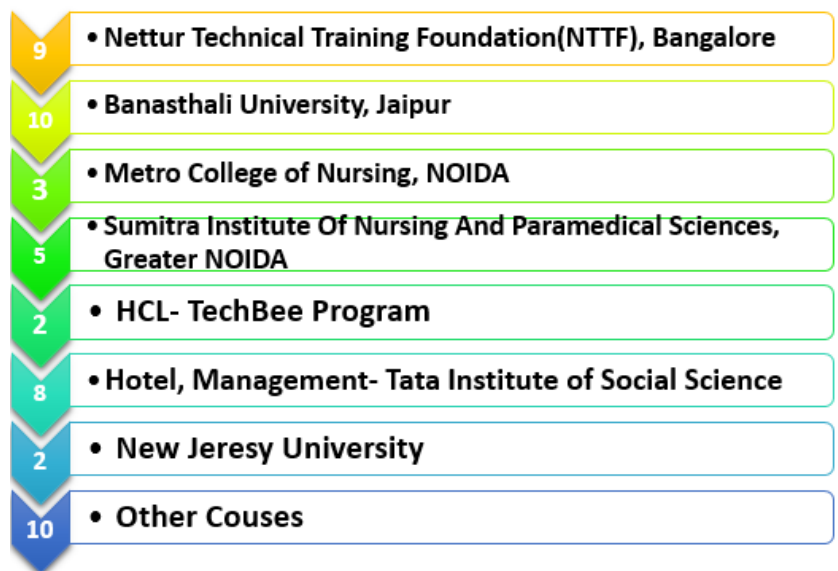


BEST WISHES TO THE 2019 PPES BATCH

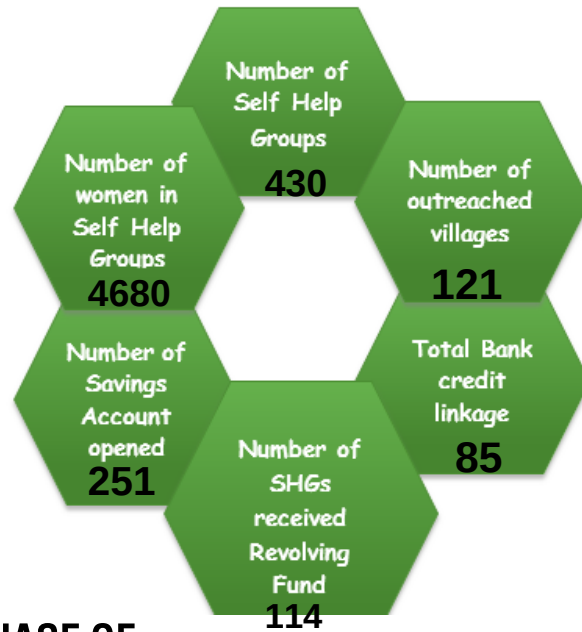

Highlights of Community Development Division till June, 2019



LAUNCH OF SECOND PHASE OF COMMUNITY HEALTH INITIATIVE



In a recent study conducted by PPES it was found that 60% of the debts are for treatments and paying hospital bills for various ailments. Surprisingly 75 % of these cost can be curtailed by following good sanitation and hygiene practice. Poor sanitation, and poor hygiene practices are the root cause of many diseases like diarrhea, cholera, dysentery, typhoid and malaria.

PPES Community Health Initiative was launched to address these issues by creating awareness on community health and good hygiene practice. In April 2019 the second phase of CHEI was launched. Under this phase, women from SHGs are being trained on two important health topics i.e. Fever Care and Asthma. Dr. Brian Gee, MD and Specialist in Family Medicine, and a team of medical volunteers conducted an orientation session to launch the second phase.

THE CHANGEMAKERS OF RURAL ANUPSHAHR

“I came to know about self-help groups a few years back. Since then I have been trying to form an SHG in our village. Three years back with the support of Pardada Pardadi we formed Valmiki SHG.

Today our group is going strong with twelve members. We support each other financially, and now no woman has to beg for money from their husbands or relatives or from money-lenders. Our inter-loaning process is simple which is liberating for all of us.”

PPES HEALTH & HYGIENE VERTICAL

SOAP DISPENSERS



During this quarter 12 soap dispensers are installed at school toilets and hand washing areas. Teaching hand hygiene is an important part of our health education. Girls are encouraged to wash their hands properly after using toilet and before taking meal. To promote hygiene practices, health monitors are selected from each class, and they take the leadership to monitor and maintain the good practices. Each of the PPES girl is now brand ambassador of social change and through them the community is becoming aware of hygiene practices.



Orphaned at an early age Khusboo used to stay with her paternal uncle, and never received love and care from them. The negligence made her a weak child who used to fall sick frequently. In January 2019 Khusboo was diagnosed with TB. With the support of Prana Health Center staff, she was admitted in Max Super Specialty Hospital, New Delhi. After the initial treatment, she was referred to the National Institute of TB and Respiratory Diseases, New Delhi. Khusboo's paternal uncle refused to pay for the treatments and completely detached himself from her. Prana Health Center staff intervened and stayed with the little girl throughout the 12 weeks treatment.

Khusboo was released from hospital in a healthy state after completing the treatment. But her uncle refused to keep her with his family. The objective of PPES Health & Hygiene vertical is not only to provide medical treatments but also to take care of the complete well-being of each of our girls. So Khusboo was shifted to PPES Guest House where she got all the required care.

A good diet and a strong immune system are key to the success of TB treatment. Khusboo's dietary intake was strictly monitored by PPES staff Nurse. Today Khusboo is recovered completely and resumed her classes. Recently, Khusboo is rehabilitated with a local family in her own village. Her well-being is taken care of by PPES.

MEDICAL VOLUNTEERS



Dr. Brian Gee, Family Medicine Specialist, Dr. Kanan Maniar Gupta, specialist in Rheumatology, Mara Darian and Anneliese Petersen, medical students volunteered with Prana Health Center in April. Dr. Brian Gee and his team of health volunteers conducted another immunization camp on 1st April for the girls who could not be vaccinated on the first camp held in March 2019. Dr. Gee and his team also conducted health workshop for the senior girls.

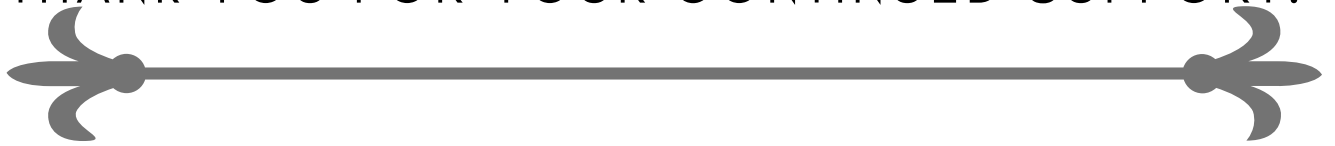

Cost of education of a girl in one year

This year we are focusing on meeting all compliance and further enhancing quality of education for the girls. We are increasing the number of buses for girls to travel to school and Hiring specialist resource persons. Factoring in inflation and little increase in above mentioned costs, per girl per year cost towards education is revised to INR 32,500 (from 1st April 2019- March 2020)
